

Short Biography (max 200 words)

I'm 46 and I'm French. After studies in history and museography, my first job was in Art and Industry Museum of Saint-Etienne to coordinate mediation devices between three collections which constituted the development of the city (weapons, ribbons and bicycles). After that, I worked for four years as a consultant in tourism and cultural engineering. Since this period, I'm convinced by the link between cultural sites as museums and tourism to participate at the development of territories. In 2006 as project manager, I followed all the steps of the creation of Great War Museum in Meaux (Paris region) and I became the director at the opening in 2011. Today, this museum is one of the most important about this theme in Europe. In 2016, I

became the director of MuseoParc Alesia in Burgundy. This is the place of the siege and battle of Alesia in 52 BC between roman army and gallic troops during Gallic Wars. MuseoParc Alesia was created in 2012 with two sites to visit: museum and gallo-roman remains. The aim was to grow up the audience and to connect this museum with the inhabitants. With the team, we managed to do that just before pandemic's years.

With my first participation at the ICOM General Conférence in Kyoto in 2019, I realized how it's important to participate in international committee. As an archaeologist and specialist in African heritage, my research focuses on the dynamics of ancient settlement in West Africa and the archaeological heritage in Senegal. We codirect international research projects on the prehistory of eastern Senegal, megalithism in Senegambia, and the shell middens of the Saloum Islands in Senegal. As vice-president of ICOM-Senegal and in partnership with the Direction of cultural Heritage, we are permanent members of the scientific committees of several museums in Senegal, whose permanent exhibition rooms on Africa, the cradle of humanity, were written and mounted by us and our associates.

I teach prehistoric archaeology and African archaeological heritage at the Department of History and at the Higher Institute of Arts and Cultures (ISAC) of the Cheikh Anta Diop University of Dakar in Senegal.

In accordance with the challenges of global change in museums, particularly those of archaeology and history, are called upon to adapt and reinvent themselves in order to meet the expectations of the public.
